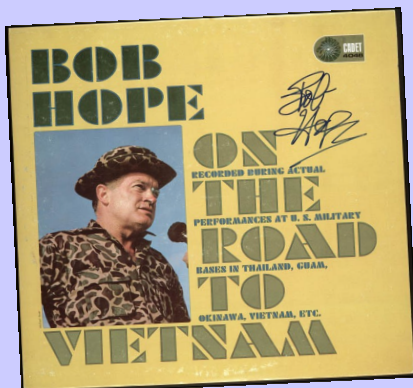

# Preliminary Itinerary

**Day 1** On our first day we will travel I-20, bypassing Atlanta and stopping in Cartersville this afternoon to explore the Booth Museum of Western Art. This museum has the largest collection of Western Art in the country and is the only museum of its kind in the Southeast. We will view America's story through contemporary Western artwork, a Presidential Gallery and a Civil War Gallery. It is the perfect introduction to our Heroes & Legends tour! We will spend the night in route to our next destination, Lynchburg, TN.

**Day 2** Today, we will travel first to Lynchburg, TN. This little community in Tennessee is well-known for several reasons. It is the home of the Jack Daniels Distillery and Ms. Mary Bobo's Boarding House. We will tour the distillery and enjoy a family style meal at Ms. Mary's. This afternoon we will travel to Clarksville, TN, recognized as one of the most 'Patriotic Towns in America' where we check into our hotel for a two night stay.

Following dinner, included, at a local restaurant, you'll enjoy a 50th Anniversary Tribute to the 1967 USO Show that featured Bob Hope's Troupe of Hollywood Gypsies at Da Nang, Cu Chi, Pleiku, Saigon and Cam Ron Bay. It stars Bill Johnson as Bob Hope and a cast of characters, mixed with real film, and live music. Following the show, we will attend an "after show" private reception at the hotel. (B, L, D, and Reception)

**Day 3** This is "Welcome Home Day" in Clarksville, home of Fort Campbell and the famed 101st Airborne Division's Screaming Eagles (Air Assault). This morning, gather your troops for the Welcome Home Parade. Sponsored by the Vietnam Veterans of America, created as "The Parade They Never Got," it is now a parade shared with all American Veterans. Any veterans traveling with us will have an opportunity march/ride in this parade.

Once lined up, veterans will have a choice to either march in units or ride in troop transport trucks. It is a Welcome Home, sponsored by the TN State Council of Vietnam Veterans of America for all former American military personnel. While there is special recognition of Vietnam Veterans, all military personnel are welcome to participate because of the VVA Founding Principle, *"Never again will one generation of veterans abandon another."*

When the parade steps off there will be a Color Guard leading Jeeps with various dignitaries, marching bands, various VVA Units marching and riding together, as well as armored and other military vehicles. The parade will feature veterans from WWII, Korea, the Persian Gulf, Afghanistan, and other conflicts, as well as men and women who served during peacetime that wish to march. The parade may also have special units of Wounded Warriors, Gold Star Mothers, and others.

Following the tour, lunch will be included with the men from the Parade.

This afternoon, tour a local Clarksville tobacco farm. Learn about the history of this million dollar industry and how Type 22 tobacco solidified Clarksville's standing in the global market through a tobacco farm. Then you will enjoy a tour & tasting at Beachaven Winery, one of the largest wineries in Tennessee.

Dinner this evening is followed by a music show or concert yet to be announced. (B, L, D)

**Day 4** This morning we begin our return home...but there is one more stop in route. We will spend our last night in Pigeon Forge at the Inn at Christmas Place—outstanding!! And, we will have reservations for "The Hatfield & McCoy Dinner Show," plus "The Country Tonight Show." It is the 20th anniversary of this show and you can be sure their show will include a special tribute to our veterans and to our country. The perfect ending of a perfect tour! (B, D)

**Day 5** Today, after enjoying breakfast, included, we will travel to South Carolina, arriving home in the early evening. We will hold our heads a little higher and wave our flags again as we remember the special events of Heroes & Legends, 2017', one of America's largest Veterans Appreciation celebration. (B)
