

# RAILROADING IN WEST VIRGINIA!

If you love trains...this tour is for you!

We will travel first to Hawk's Nest State Park and enjoy the New River Gorge area. While there, we will enjoy the magnificent New River Gorge/Bridge area...take a tram ride down to the river from the lodge, followed by an optional jet boat ride through the Gorge! We'll also check out the New River Bridge Visitor's Center and scenic overlook. On this, the 2nd afternoon of the tour, we will make our way to Elkins, WV. This evening we will enjoy reserved seating at the American Mountain Theatre. On the third day of our tour, we experience two great trains of the Durbin & Greenbrier Valley Railroad! These trains will transport you into some of the best scenery this side of the Rockies. You will roll through deep canyons featuring narrow passages beside sheer rock walls with vivid views of unspoiled mountains, and scenic cascading rivers. You will climb to over 4,000 feet in elevation, burrow under the mighty Cheat Mountain (via an 1,800 foot tunnel featuring an "S" curve of the track inside), and negotiate the two sharpest mainline railroad curves in the U.S.! We will enjoy a family-style dinner in the Railyard Restaurant and the new Gandy Dinner Theatre, rated #1 activity in Elkins. Our hotel is right next door—we'll stay at the Holiday Inn Express for the 2 nights we're in Elkins. Meals include 3 breakfasts, 1 lunch and 2 dinners.



Nestled in the heart of whitewater rafting country, Hawks Nest State Park borders a rugged section of the New River Gorge National River.

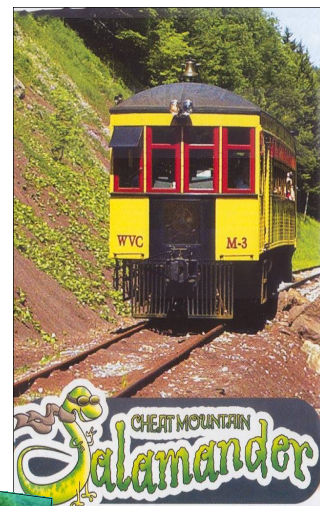
We will take the tram from the lodge to the bottom of the gorge, plus their jetboat ride for great photo opportunities!
